NOMINATION ESSAY QUESTIONS

The nomination form will ask you to provide responses to the following five (5) essay questions. Within the provided word counts, describe why you feel this nominee is deserving of the New Mexico Nursing Excellence Award. Please cite specific examples of accomplishments referring to the criteria listed for the specific award category.

These essay responses must be blinded. This means the nominee's name is not included in any of the following responses. If the answers are not fully blinded, your nominee may not be eligible for judging.

1. **How does this nurse demonstrate outstanding delivery of patient care and participation/leadership in patient/client services? (30% scoring weight) 250 words max**
 - ❖ Provides care and models behavior that is aligned with organizational values.

2. **Does this nurse practice safe patient care and participate in activities and practices that improve patient/client satisfaction? (25% scoring weight) 250 words max**
 - ❖ Responsiveness, positive communication skills, develops caring relationships

3. **How is this nurse a positive role model for the nursing profession? (20% scoring weight) 200 words max**

4. How does this nurse assist in team cohesiveness and support positive team dynamics?
(15% scoring weight) 200 words max
5. Does this nurse seek opportunities to increase knowledge and skills to meet future challenges of the profession? (10% scoring weight) 100 words max

Important Instructions

In order for a nominee to be considered for an award, all information requested must be provided.

This includes:

- 1) A completed online nomination form from our website:
www.nmnursingexcellence.org/nomination-categories
- 1) Payment of the \$100 Nomination Fee. With the payment of the nomination fee, Nominees receive a complimentary ticket for their dinner/entry to the event.

Please Note:

- A nurse may **not** be nominated again in the same category in which they have won previously.
- DO NOT provide identifying information in your essay. This is an anonymous process with all nominations blinded.
- The New Mexico Nursing Excellence Award Selection Committee reserves the right to place nominees in the category that best fits their nomination and/or enhances the nominee's ability to compete for the award.
